B.F. Hagerman Series

f.1-19 1852-1863. Correspondence with Yeatman Pittman and Co.; Waterman and Ryan; Woods Christy and Co.; Coen McCreery and Co., St. Louis; and B. Douglas and Co., Philadelphia, Pa. Concerned with collecting debts, paying taxes and speculating in money. Also accounts and receipts and miscellaneous items.

Linnetta Hagerman Series

f.20-45 1862-1893. Correspondence of Keokuk, Iowa, girl who attended the Academy of the Visitation, St. Louis, 1868-1872. Miscellaneous items.
f. 34-44 Letters written by an art teacher at the academy, 1873-1875

P.C. Hayden Series

f.46-49 1879-1886. Letters to a music student at Oberlin, Ohio, from his family in Hempstead, New York, and others, concerning personal affairs. He started teaching in Quincy, Illinois, in 1883.

Miscellaneous Series

f.50-51 Three letters to Frank Hagerman, lawyer of Keokuk, Iowa, 1865-1866; postal cards bearing images of buildings in Kansas City, Chicago, and elsewhere. Includes hotel menu, 1869; pamphlet of Scott Brown's

College of Phonography, N.Y.C., n.d.; stock certificate, Morse American Telegraph, 1852. Newspaper clippings, brief for case involving a railroad.
