Correspondence, pamphlets, photographs, newspapers, and other material relating to the history of Marshall and Saline County, MO. The collection is composed of items that Hall, an employee of the Marshall DAILY DEMOCRAT NEWS, collected from a variety of sources over the years.

Eubank concerning a storm in Kentucky in 1870; letter from Post Office Department to Hall (1939) enclosing a list of all post offices in Saline County and the postmasters who served them; and several letters from Willard McDermott to Hall concerning Saline County history, including a typescript of an excerpt from a diary written in 1849 by James A. Pritchard and a typescript of an 1834 letter from a slave, James Hope, to his master, Judge Beverly Tucker.
f. 2	Letters concerned with the history of Saline County and information on the Friends of Arrow Rock and the Arrow Rock Lyceum.
f. 3	Contains material on Fort Orleans, a French fort built along the Missouri River in Saline County in 1723. Includes information on and maps of the fort and the surrounding area, most of which appeared in an article in the 5 February 1963 issue of the Marshall <u>Daily Democrat News</u> .

f. 7	Photographs. Covered bridge near Napton, Missouri; old Saline County jail; Methodist Episcopal Church, Marshall; Major-General Mosby Monroe Parsons; and Chapel Hill and McGee colleges. Also includes a short history of the covered bridge and information on the church.

f. 8	Literary Productions. Reminiscence by I.G. Dyer of a horse race held at the Old Saline County Fair in August 1914 and miscellaneous notes.
f. 9	Legal Documents. Pension certificate for Mary E. Swap, 1902, and typescript of affidavits signed by commissioners empowered to build a road through Saline County, 1841.
f. 10	Newspapers. <u>Georgetown (KY) Gazette</u> , 7 December 1859; and two pages from <u>New York Semi-Weekly Tribune</u> , 6 April 1860. Also clippings concerning the history of Missouri Valley College, Mary E. Swap, Charles Quantrell Hart, and the Friends of Arrow Rock.
