INTRODUCTION

A 1930 memoir of Confederate soldier Joel Monroe Bolton of Jefferson City, MO, who served as a sergeant in a cavalry regiment in the West throughout the Civil War.

The memoir was donated to the State Historical Society of Missouri by Mr. and Mrs. Douglas M. Bolton on 3 October 1985 (Accession No. 2574).

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The memoir consists of seventeen handwritten pages and is a chronological account from enlistment in 1861 to the end of the war. The memoir also includes a list of the battles and skirmishes in Missouri and Arkansas in which Bolton participated.
