INTRODUCTION

The papers of Martin L. Faust, professor of political science at the University of Missouri, contain a book on personal materials compiled by Faust, and two student papers.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The book on personnel materials is composed of articles by various authors on the spoils system, personnel programs, the English Civil Service, St. Louis charter provisions on civil service, the functioning of municipal civil service and personnel, and the university graduate in civil service. The student papers concern police administration in St. Louis, 1932, and the executive budget of Missouri, 1951-1953.
