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INTRODUCTION

Business and personal papers of a Mexico, Missouri, fire brick manufacturer. Correspondence with family members; business associates in U.S., Europe, and South America; as trustee of Westminster College and member of Board of Visitors of University of Missouri; and with miscellaneous business and charitable organizations.

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Allen P. Green was born in Jefferson City, Missouri, in 1875, the son of Joseph H. Green and Eliza McHenry Green. He attended school in Sedalia and at the Missouri School of Mines and Metallurgy in Rolla. Green worked as a civil and mining engineer, as general sales manager for Harbison-Walker Refractories Company in Pittsburgh and as vice-president of Evens and Howard Fire Brick Company of St. Louis.

In 1910 Green founded the A.P. Green Fire Brick Company of Mexico, Missouri. He acted as its president from 1910 to 1946 and as chairman of the board from 1946 until his death. Green was also president or board member of various subsidiary companies in the United States, South America, and Europe. He was a Democrat and a Presbyterian.

On June 17, 1903, Green married Josephine Brown. Their children were Elizabeth C. Green, Martha McHenry Green, Josephine Green, Allen Percival Green, Jr., and Robert Stafford Green. Elizabeth married Arthur D. Bond. Martha married Walter G. Staley and Josephine married Neal S. Wood.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The papers have been arranged into the following three series: **Correspondence**; **Personal Bills and Receipts**; and **Brick Plant News**.

The **Correspondence** series covers almost the entire collection and contains Green family letters, telegrams; inventory of furnishings of Miami residence; insurance policies held by Green; Walter Staley's resignation from Army; 1929 income tax dispute and affidavits connected with review of 1929 federal income tax; recommendations to form Green family trust, its provisions and minutes; pamphlet on layout of Miami home in oversize.

The **Personal Bills and Receipts** series cover bills for goods and services, receipts, tax receipts and miscellaneous correspondence concerning personal finances. This section of Green's papers is arranged chronologically by year, month, and day according to billing date, date of services or purchase, or date of receipt.

The *Brick Plant News* series consists of bound copies of the *Brick Plant News*, September 23, 1941-December 24, 1942. The *Brick Plant News* was the bi-monthly company newspaper of the A.P. Green Fire Brick Company.
