### INTRODUCTION

The records of the Brunswick Fire Department contain meeting minutes, election of officers, lists of members, financial records, and lists of fires, dating from organization in November 1894, through January 1939.

### DONOR INFORMATION

The records were loaned for microfilming to the University of Missouri by David Blake Sasse on 27 July 1990 (Accession No. 4967).

### ORGANIZATIONAL SKETCH

This volunteer fire department was organized on 14 November 1894. The official rules and regulations were passed by the City Council and unanimously approved by the Fire Department at their meeting on 10 December 1894. Organized with two companies of eleven men each, the department held annual elections for president, vice president, treasurer, and secretary as well as for chief, assistant chief, two captains and two assistant captains.

### SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The minutes include information on fund raising events, the purchase of equipment, duties, membership and elections. Following page 227 are lists of firemen and fires fought. These lists are not in chronological order. The fire records include the location, equipment used, members in attendance, cause and amount of damage.
