INTRODUCTION

The papers of Arnold Lien contain correspondence, pamphlets, photographs, diplomas, a Master's thesis, published and unpublished writings, newspaper clippings, and original poetry of Dr. Arnold J. Lien, professor of political science, who bequeathed his papers to the State Historical Society of Missouri.

DONOR INFORMATION

The papers were donated to the State Historical Society of Missouri by Arnold J. Lien through Sander B. Zwick in March and July of 1964 (Accession No. 261).

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Dr. Arnold J. Lien was born in Delavan, Minnesota, on November 27, 1886, and died in St. Louis, Missouri, on October 7, 1963. He received his A.M. degree from the University of Minnesota in 1909 and his Ph.D. from Columbia University in 1913. His teaching positions included political science teaching at the University of Colorado and Washington University. He was made chairman of the Political Science Department at Washington University in 1924, serving until 1952. At that time, he was made Professor Emeritus, a title he held until his death. During World War I, he was a captain in the American Red Cross in Luxembourg.
