INTRODUCTION

Church record book of the Crooked Creek Cumberland Presbyterian Church, which began in Keysville and later moved to Steelville. The church was established in 1834 by John Dunlap, Reuben Vaughn, Mr. Keys, and several others. There are several large gaps in this material: 1880-1884, 1895-1902, 1913-1925, and a few smaller ones.

DONOR INFORMATION

The records were donated to the State Historical Society of Missouri by Clarke Dunlap on 08 Dec 1976 (Accession No. 2047).

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

Records the names of pastors who served the congregation, including T.S. Love; the election of delegates to attend meetings of the St. Louis Presbytery; the visitation of a committee to various members to discuss their Christian conduct and church membership; and the receiving and baptism of new members, as well as requests for letters of dismission and recommendation for departing members. These minutes of church business meetings provide a detailed account of the church's membership, but are incomplete due to the many gaps.
