INTRODUCTION

Negatives of portraits believed to be from a photographic studio in Osage County, Missouri.

DONOR INFORMATION

The Weeks' Photographic Studio, Linn, Missouri, Glass Plate Negatives were donated to the University of Missouri on 25 November 1992 by the Osage County Historical Society (Accession No. 5236).

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Weeks' Photographic Studio, Linn, Missouri, Glass Plate Negatives are arranged in no particular order. At the time the negatives were donated to the university each negative was given a number, which was also assigned to the corresponding print copy. Most of the negatives are damaged in some way, being scratched, faded, or flaking. A few are broken or chipped. None are labelled as to subject, date, or place.

This collection includes images of men, women, children, and families. Some of the men are dressed in post-Civil War military uniforms, and there are a handful of pictures of Indians, indicating these pictures might have been taken on or near a reservation.
