INTRODUCTION

Letters written to Elam O. Graham from Anna Louise Reck Graham, before and after their marriage. The contents include their courtship, marriage, and references to their son, Myron. The years covered are 1906 and 1907. The 1915 material contains one letter from Elam O. Graham to his mother, Flora Kendall Graham, shortly before her death. The remainder of the letters are from family and friends to Elam expressing sympathy regarding his mother's death. Elam Graham was a salesman for the Marks Shoe Company and the family resided in Kansas City, Missouri.
