INTRODUCTION

The volumes consist of one cash account ledger and two merchandise ledgers.

The ledgers were donated to the State Historical Society of Missouri by Barbara W. Icenogle on 12 August 1987 (Accession No. 2667).

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Hiram Wilcoxson was born May 10, 1805, the oldest of five sons. Prior to 1820, his parents moved the family to Howard County, Missouri. In the spring of 1835, Hiram was herding mules on the Grand River, and later in that same year he moved to Carroll County to the town of Carrollton, where he established a store in 1836.

Hiram joined two of his brothers in California during the Civil War, but returned to Carrollton in 1866, to establish the bank Wilcoxson and Company, with his brother, Harrison Wilcoxson. Hiram Wilcoxson was identified with the bank until his death in 1872.
