The **Lorenzo Greene** material consists of research notes and files, publications, manuscripts, diaries, and correspondence created during Dr. Greene's professional career. Family papers—including correspondence, newspaper clippings, photographs, audiovisual and other miscellaneous material—are located in the **Greene Family Papers** portion of the collection.
