INTRODUCTION

Carroll H. Bunch, of Hannibal, Missouri, served in the 149th Aero Squadron during World War I. This collection documents his experiences with postcards, snapshots, illustrations and prints. Most of the photographs are of airplanes, but images of soldiers in training camp and locations in England and France are included as well.

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Carroll H. Bunch was born on November 20, 1886, in Atlanta, Missouri. In 1917, he enlisted in the U.S. Army and served in the 149th Aero Squadron during World War I as an aerial photographer. Following completion of his service in 1918, he married Frances Curtis in 1921. Bunch worked as a streetcar conductor, and later as a cement inspector for the Missouri Highway Commission. He was also associated with the Hannibal Connecting Railroad, the First Christian Church, and was a member of the Emmette J. Shields Post No. 55, American Legion. Bunch retired in 1961 and died on September 4, 1969.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection contains black and white photographs, photographic postcards, illustrations and prints depicting Bunch's experience as a World War I service member in the United States, England, and France. Many of the photographs were taken by Bunch. The original scrapbook has been photocopied and dismantled for conservation purposes. Photographs are arranged according to their original order.
