Organizational records of the Greater Kansas City Section, including administrative, financial, membership, committee, publications, and public relations files.

HISTORY:

The Greater Kansas City Section of the National Council of Jewish Women was founded in August of 1893 at the home of Mrs. Louis Lieberman. Mrs. Lieberman, the Section's first president, had received a letter from Mrs. Hannah G. Solomon, founder of the parent organization, encouraging the establishment of a Kansas City Section. Together with Mrs. Lieberman there were seventeen charter members.

The organization was and remains "dedicated in the spirit of Judaism to advancing human welfare and the democratic way of life." By providing a coordinated program of education, services, advocacy and social action, the NCJW attempts to achieve this goal and to fulfill unmet needs within the Jewish and the general communities. It aims to unite Jewish women interested in the works of religion, philanthropy, education and social reform. An attached list of benchmarks and projects gives a clear indication of the variety and depth of programming undertaken to achieve these goals in the history of the Kansas City Section.

PROVENANCE:

The Greater Kansas City Section, National Council of Jewish Women loaned these records to the Western Historical Manuscript Collection-Kansas City so they

could be microfilmed. They were received as accession KA0272 on March 5, 1985. On July 30, 1998, the records, plus additional materials, were donated as KA1002. Accession KA1914 was received March 3, 2011.

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DESCRIPTION:

The records are divided into three groups relating to the local section, the district office and the national organization. The Kansas City Section group is arranged into series:

ADMINISTRATIVE (folders 1 - 68), contains correspondence, speeches, notes, minutes, bylaws and policies, board committee materials, annual reports and committee annual reports;

FINANCIAL RECORDS (folders 69 - 71), including budgets, audits, and other accounting documents;

MEMBERSHIP RECORDS (folder 72);

PUBLICATIONS (folders 73 - 150), containing the section newsletters, the yearbooks or membership rosters and a series of notices, announcements and other ephemera which the Section distributed;

COMMITTEE MATERIALS (folders 151 - 188), including planning notes, correspondence and associated materials relating to the conduct of the various committees and projects of the Section;

CLIPPINGS (folders 189 - 217) from newspapers, magazines and newsletters related to the activities of the Section and its members;

PHOTOGRAPHS (folder 218) of Section activities and members; and,

SCRAPBOOKS (volumes 1 - 12), containing clippings, photographs, memorabilia and other documents related to the activities of the Section, it's committees and members;

The materials from the Central District office (folders 219 - 220) and the National office of the organization (folders 221 - 225) include newsletters, bylaws and policy statements, and various publications.

It should be clear from the contents of the records that these materials do not represent a complete documentation of the activities of the Greater Kansas City Section of the National Council of Jewish Women.
