*Minutes, contacts/leases, correspondence, and maps for an oil and coal company which operated in Coal County, OK. Kansas City realtor Newton Booth Childs (1849-1925) was an officer of the company.*

### HISTORY:

In 1892, Newton Booth Childs (1849-1925) bought leases from the Choctaw and Chicksaw Nations for the purpose of mining oil and coal. He mined these territories until 1916, when he leased the land in Coal County, OK, to the Clear Boggy Oil and Gas Company. The company developed the lands for oil, gas, and other minerals.

The company was successful until Childs, who was vice president, died March 16, 1925. The company was left to Mrs. Nellie B. Childs, and very little business was done while she owned it.
