BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Dr. Eugene Payne Chatman was an African American physician, with offices at 1731 Brooklyn Avenue and later 2200 E. 18th Street, both in Kansas City, Missouri. Dr. Chatman was born in Alabama in 1902 and attended Meharry Medical College in Nashville, Tennessee. He was married to Selma D. Chatman (1902-1993) and died in 1984 in Inglewood, California.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The records contain a delivery room record book documenting deliveries performed by Dr. Eugene Payne Chatman. The entries include patient names; names of attending nurses; dates and times of delivery; the gender of the children; and clinical details about the deliveries. The entries are arranged by delivery number and date.
