The collection contains the memoir of Frederick W. Moody. The memoir contains stories regarding his immigration to the United States from England in 1857, his travels to New Mexico, Colorado, and early life in Kansas City.

#### BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Frederick W. Moody was born in Hampshire, England, on January 10, 1838. In 1857, the Moody family left England and immigrated to the United States, where they settled in Kansas City. Moody was primarily employed in hauling goods along the western trails, which he did with his older brother. Moody married in 1869, and in 1916 moved to California. Moody died in 1937.

#### SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection consists of one folder.

Folder one contains a **Memoir** and consists of a single typed document recounting the life of Frederick W. Moody. The memoir primarily focuses on interesting things that happened to Moody on his travels and his recollections of life on the frontier.
