BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Indiana native Harrison H. George worked for the United States Department of Agriculture's Bureau of Animal Husbandry in Kansas City from the late 1800s to the early 1900s. He also lived in Kansas City during this time. George died in 1929.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection consists of forty-one photographs taken ca. 1900-ca. 1903, including many showing the Kansas City Stockyards and sites in Kansas City, Kansas. The collection includes photographs of livestock in the Kansas City Stockyards and near the Swift and Company packing plant; people with livestock, including horses and carriages; people, including photographs of individuals associated with Swift and Company and Bond Shoe Company; buildings, including some at Midland Park in Kansas City, Kansas, and the Armour Packing Company facility; damage from the 1903 flood, including the Swift and Company plant under water, a wrecked locomotive, wreckage above the Central Avenue Viaduct, and the State Bank of Commerce; and scenery, including Pike's Peak railroad in Colorado.
