The *Television Preview Magazine Collection* is comprised of bound magazines from November 1951 to August 1952 and from August 1953 to April 1954 that have been microfilmed on one reel.

ORGANIZATIONAL SKETCH

Television Preview published its first issue on November 28, 1951. The aim was to create the first entertainment magazine for the Greater Kansas City area. The magazine was released bi-weekly for fifteen cents per issue. The magazine had a wide circulation area including homes in Armour Fields, Crestwood, Mission Hills, Prairie Village, Sunset Hills, and Romanelli Gardens among others.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection is comprised of bound copies of *Television Preview* organized chronologically on microfilm. In addition to containing the television program schedule for every day of the two week-period of its release, they also contain information and articles about radio, records, theatre, sports, concerts, and other related entertainment information. This collection is available on microfilm only.
