Introduction

The records consist of two bound volumes containing meeting minutes, membership records, marriage and death records, lists of trustees, and resignation letters of pastors, covering the period 1879-1922. The second volume continued to be updated with member information after the unification of the First Congregational Church with Pilgrim Presbyterian Church in 1920.

Historical Sketch

The First Congregational Church of Cameron, Missouri, was established around 1879. A membership crisis occurred in 1917, at which time the Pilgrim Presbyterian Church offered to unite with the Congregationalists. The church's property was sold to the Missouri Congregational Conference in 1919, and in 1920 a large group of parishioners joined with the Presbyterians.
