The collection consists of note cards and obituaries of many Jewish men and women in the Kansas City area compiled by Anita Boresow Loeb. This information was collected by Loeb as part of her Jewish Cemetery Project and was later assembled in a book.

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Anita Boresow Loeb was born in Kansas City, Missouri in 1929 to Abe and Leah Boresow. She married Walter M. Loeb (1922-1999) in 1949 and had four daughters with him. Loeb has actively contributed to the Jewish community for many years. Among her work she served as chairwoman of the library and resource committee that established a library in the Hartman Elementary School of Kansas City (1962-1963), librarian for the Beth Shalom Congregation (1964-1974); chairwoman for the Children's Book Award Committee of the National Jewish Libraries Association; first administrative secretary for the Jewish Education Council, now the Central Agency for Jewish Education (1966-1972); first registrar of the Community High School of Jewish Studies (1966-1972); first business manager for the Hyman Brand Hebrew Academy (1973-1990); and the first director of the Jewish Veterans Museum Association (1990-1992). Loeb has compiled an alphabetical listing and personal information of Jewish individuals in her book, *Gone But Not Forgotten*.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection is comprised entirely of personal information on Jewish individuals in the Kansas City area compiled mostly from Jewish cemeteries in the area. This information is intended to contribute to the incomplete records of the Jewish community of Kansas City. The information is collected on note cards or obituaries and arranged alphabetically. This collection is available on microfilm only.
