The collection contains documents and meeting minutes pertaining to the Old Plainsmen Association in Independence, Missouri.

HISTORICAL SKETCH

The Old Plainsmen Association met annually in Independence, Missouri, from 1909 to 1917. Individuals who crossed the plains prior to the last year of the Civil War were encouraged to join. According to the meeting minutes, "plains" was defined as the "great country West of the Missouri River."

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection consists of various documents and newspaper clippings about the Old Plainsmen Association and a bound volume of meeting minutes. Among the various documents is a certificate of membership to James R. Bowlin. The meeting minutes contain a list of members, including age, address, and year they crossed the plains.
