Collected materials gathered or produced by Recycled Sounds, a Westport MO phonograph record store owned by Winters and Schlemmer. Includes "Recycled Sounds" magazine issues, newspaper articles; and a few photographs, and posters handbills and promotional materials of various rock bands and venues in the Kansas City area, and materials concerning the Greater Kansas City Coalition against Censorship.

BIOGRAPHY:

In 1988, Anne Winter, a graduate of the University of Nebraska-Lincoln, moved to Kansas City and along with a partner, opened Dirt Cheap Recycled Sounds. By 1992, Anne had married Kurt von Schlemmer, bought out her partner, and changed the business name to Recycled Sounds. Their business became the nerve center for local, independent and underground music.

Recycled Sounds regularly hosted in store performances by local and touring bands in all genres, including an 11 hour art and performance event for Amnesty International. They also provided prime retail space for CDs produced by local bands under independent labels.

Winter helped start the Greater Kansas City Coalition Against Censorship, in 1988. She was "Orphan Annie", a DJ for Kansas City's first Garage/Punk radio show, on KKFI, 90.1FM.

In addition to managing the advertising and bookkeeping for Recycled Sounds, Von Schlemmer, an artist, also became a partner in the Foundry, an important venue for all-ages music and art shows.

After 17 years in business, Winter and von Schlemmer decided it was time for a change. Winter became membership director for an international professional association. Von Schlemmer became a licensed massage therapist. Recycled Sounds was closed in the summer of 2006.
