Personal papers of civic leader, educator, and an active member of the Jewish Community in Kansas City. Includes correspondence, pamphlets, clippings, information, booklets, papers on organizations with which Rosenwald was involved such as the National Council of Jewish Women (NCJW), UNESCO, Missouri Association for Social Welfare, and Conference on Families. Rosenwald was prolific traveler and included is material she gathered from across the globe over their many decades.

BIOGRAPHY:

Dorothy Shubart Rosenwald was born May 15, 1916 in Denver, Colorado to Benedict and Daisy Newhouse Shubart. She was a Phi Beta Kappa graduate of Mills College. She was President of the Kansas City chapter of the NCJW (National Council of Jewish Women) as well as a National Vice-President. Dorothy was instrumental in bringing CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) to Kansas City. She served as President of her sons' PTA and on the boards of many organizations including CASA, MASW (Missouri Association for Social Welfare) and JFS (Jewish Family Services). During the 1950's and 60's Dorothy and her husband, Robert E. Rosenwald aided many Iraqi Jewish and Cuban refugees to get political asylum in the United States. They were among the very early American tourists to visit Mainland China in the 1970's and helped several Chinese families obtain United States residency, providing a place in their home for them while they were studying locally.
