Moey Mokofsky was born on March 6, 1908. He lived in Shawnee Mission, Kansas, where he was an active member in the Irari Club and the Ohava Torah Anshy Polin Congregation. He passed away on October 22, 1978, and is buried at the Mount Carmel Cemetery in Raytown, Missouri.
