Historical Note:

The Northeast Community Center was founded in 1908 by the Kansas City Central Presbyterian Church. Governed by the Italian Mission, the community center provided services to Kansas City's northeast Italian community. These services included medical care, childcare, English lessons, and education.

Today, the Northeast Community Center continues to service and provide resources to underserved families in Kansas City, Missouri's northeast communities. Over the years it has formed partnerships with other not-for-profit agencies in the area in an effort to help coordinate a movement toward improving the lives of the residents of the northeast communities.

Arrangement:

The records have been arranged chronologically by the processor.

Scope and Content Note:

The records consist of three sets of architectural drawings for the Northeast Community Center and Christ Presbyterian Church. These drawings include, a social service building designed by Boillot and Lauck in 1940 and 1945, additions done to the church done by Hollis and Miller in 1971, and the David Educational Building designed by Arthur Kriehn in 1948 with additions in 1964.
