BIOGRAPHY:

Abe "Butch" Rabin was born in Kansas City, Missouri to David and Sarah Rabin. He married Sara Stolov and had one son, Robert D. Rabin. Butch served as Jackson County Courthouse Constable for 20 years, retiring in 1981. He was a member of Congregation Kehilath Israel and had served as president of B'nai B'rith. He was a member of the Native Sons of Kansas City, the City of Hope, Club 100, the Richards-Gebaur Base Community Council, the Heroine Masonic Lodge and the Ararat Shrine. Butch was a volunteer Santa Claus for the Mayor's Christmas Tree Fund, Children's Mercy Hospital and Immaculata Manor. He also was a volunteer at Baptist Medical Center.

Sara Stolov was born in Kansas City, Missouri to Jake and Bessie Aronson Stolov. She was a member of Kehilath Israel Synagogue, Hadassah, Jewish Women International, and the Harriet Dubinsky Chapter, City of Hope.
