HISTORY:

The Dixie Chapter #2188 of the United Daughters of the Confederacy received its charter on August 20, 1952. The original eight members and their successors were authorized to be located at Kansas City in Jackson County, Missouri. As stated in their constitution, "The business and objects of the Society are historical, benevolent, educational, and patriotic- to honor the memory of those who served and those who fell in the service of the Confederate States; to protect, preserve, and mark places made historic by Confederate valor; to collect and preserve the material for a truthful history of the War Between the States; to record the part taken by Southern Women in patient endurance of hardship and patriotic devotion during the struggle. . . ."

Beatrice Cornish, past president of the Dixie Chapter #2188, is the sole remaining member of the chapter.

PROVENANCE:

This gift was received from Beatrice Cornish as accession KA1420 on November 21, 2005. An additional accession KA1435 was received February 14, 2006. Accession KA1439 was received February 22, 2006. Another addition, KA1456 was received on May 22, 2006.

DESCRIPTION:

This collection consists of materials specific to the Dixie Chapter #2188 U.D.C., including 7 scrapbooks, by-laws, minutes, reports, clippings, and miscellaneous documents. Also included is information related to other Missouri Division Chapters; the Kansas City Chapter #149, the Clay County, and the Clay-Platte Battalion Chapter #2372. Several folders contain minutes, rosters, reports and history of the Missouri Division, U.D.C. Publications include: proceedings of the U.D.C. annual conventions; programs from annual breakfasts; handbooks; United Daughters of the Confederacy magazine; Confederate Veteran magazine; and various Civil War related pamphlets.
