**Abstract:** This collection consists of the photographic work of Raymond Corey, a staff photographer for *The Kansas City Star* from 1965 to 1980. The collection primarily contains negatives, slides, and photographs produced by Corey in the course of his career with *The Kansas City Star*. Additionally, there is a scrapbook of newspaper clippings containing the articles in which Corey's work appeared, and oversize photographic reproductions of his work.

**Historical Note:**

Raymond Corey was born May 1, 1936, to Mae and John Corey in Kansas City, Missouri. Corey's parents were separated prior to his birth, and he had little contact with his father. When Corey was 16, his mother died of a heart attack, leaving him on his own.

It was during this time that Corey took a position with the Associated Press located in the *Kansas City Star* building. Corey's primary task was transmitting and receiving photographs. This began Corey's lifelong love of newspapers and photography. Although Corey never finished high school, many of the members of the Associated Press became his mentors and teachers.

In order to fulfill his dream of being a news photographer, Corey borrowed money to buy a used camera. He began shooting sports and news events and gained experience composing, developing, printing, and even selling a few photographs.

In 1959, Corey got his first job as a news photographer with the *Coffeyville Journal*. Corey stayed in this position until 1963, when he was hired by *The Kansas City Kansan*. While working for the *Kansan*, Corey earned a National Press Photographer's Association Award for a photograph of a criminal being apprehended by police after robbing the Brotherhood State Bank.

In 1965, Corey began working for *The Kansas City Star* as a staff photographer. While working for the *Star* he followed social, political, and sporting events, including the Kansas City race riots in 1968, the funeral of Harry S. Truman in 1972, and the Teacher Strikes of 1974. Corey worked for the *Star* until he retired in 1979. He continued to work as a freelance photographer until his death in 1995.

**Scope and Content Note:****Biographical**

This series contains certificates and awards that Corey earned throughout his career, miscellaneous correspondence between Corey and professional colleagues, and photographs of Raymond Corey.

**Event Photography**

This series consists of negatives, slides, and photographs that Corey took while on assignment as a staff photographer. The negatives subseries forms the bulk of the collection and spans the majority of Corey's career as a photographer. The social, political, and sporting events of Kansas City from the 1960's through the 1980's are reflected in these images. The events that Corey covered included the Kansas City race Riots, Kansas City Chiefs football games, political rallies, labor actions, Harry S. Truman's funeral, American Royal events, and personal interest pieces. Corey kept the majority of his assignments separated and identified. Corey's system of separation and order, along with the titles that Corey created for these images, has been maintained for researchers, and is searchable by folder and title in the appendix. There is also a large quantity of unidentified negatives. Where possible, these have been left in the same order that Corey maintained. In addition, this subseries includes some unidentified negatives that Corey left rolled. These negatives have been separated into a large volume of bound folders, with the quantity of rolls indicated.

The slides subseries consists primarily of unidentified materials. Corey organized the slides into separate boxes. This separation has been maintained for the researcher, with dates when available, and can be found in the appendix. The photographs subseries consists primarily of selected photographs that were developed for the purposes of exhibition, display, or entry into photographic competitions. These images have been separated by title and identified when possible. They can also be found in the appendix.

**Personal Papers**

This series consists of a photocopied scrapbook. The scrapbook spanned the bulk of Corey's work at *The Kansas City Star* and consists of newspaper clippings, which feature the photographs Corey took as staff photographer along with the accompanying article. The State Historical Society of Missouri does not possess the original scrapbook. This series has been arranged chronologically.

**Oversize**

This series consists primarily of oversize reproductions of Corey's work. There are oversize exhibit pieces and photographs of some of Corey's more famous photographs. In addition, there are some publications which include Corey's work.
