ORGANIZATIONAL SKETCH

Since its founding in 1966, the Hyman Brand Hebrew Academy has served as a Jewish education center based in Overland Park, Kansas. The school's namesake, Hyman Brand, was the first president of the institution and held this role until his death in 1977. The Academy began its first year with 33 students and the continual increase in enrollment since its founding has allowed the school to grow and move into the Jewish Community Campus where it currently resides.

The **Hyman Brand Academy Booklets** series contains numerous Annual Civic Service Award Dinner booklets as well as two Commemorative Calendars for the Hyman Brand Hebrew Academy. Some of the folders also contain various documents pertaining to the corresponding event such as programs and honorary guest lists.

The **Zeldin Family** series consists of material pertaining to Joyce and Stan Zeldin as well as their son Jordan. Collected are newspaper clippings featuring the Zeldins, a booklet for an event honoring Jordan Zeldin, and documents referencing the synagogue the family attended.

The **Oversize** series contains an additional Annual Civic Service Award Dinner booklet and a newspaper featuring the Kehilath Israel Synagogue associated with the Zeldins.
