#### BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Dorothy Gottlieb (1903-1996) was born in New York City. When Gottlieb's husband died in 1973, she moved to Prairie Village, Kansas. She became active in Hadassah and in her synagogue. Ella Gottlieb Ullman is Dorothy Gottlieb's daughter.

#### SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The papers contain news clippings, certificates, and photographs. The news clippings are from *The Kansas City Jewish Chronicle* and feature articles related to Beth Shalom Congregation, Hadassah, and the Jewish Community Center. The certificates include an attestation of pilgrimage, service awards from Hadassah, and certificates of appreciation from the Jewish Community Center and Beth Shalom Synagogue. The photographs include an image of Dorothy Gottlieb (c. 1938-1943), an image of Governor Carlin (1986), and two undated images of Dorothy Gottlieb.
