The collection contains diaries, journals, and correspondence written to and from Jeannetta (Sawyer) Danford. The collection also includes a 1949 yearbook from Central High School, St. Joseph, Missouri, and a Bible.

Jeannetta Sawyer was born March 7, 1932, in St. Joseph, Missouri, to Ralph and Juanita Adams Sawyer. She graduated from Central High School in 1949 and graduated from Missouri Western State College with a Bachelor of Science degree in education. On August 31, 1952, Jeannetta married Thaddus Danford, Jr. and together they had three children. Jeannetta retired in 1999, after teaching 20 years with the Savannah R III School District and John Glenn Elementary. Jeannetta Danford died April 28, 2016, at age 84.
