The papers of Attie Shanks contain genealogical materials for southeastern Missouri compiled by Attie Shanks. The records cover the 'Upper Hog Creek' area of eastern Bollinger and western Cape Girardeau counties.

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Attie Zelpha Mitchell Shanks began clipping newspaper notes and collecting verbal information for her scrapbooks around 1890, beginning a life-long hobby of genealogy. Shanks died June 2, 1969 in Calgary, Canada.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The original notebook of this collection was nearly 390 pages and copies were made of the original. This photocopy of the records is only a partial copy ending at page 334 of the original. The papers include a partial index, notes by Mrs. Odis Eaker and foreword by Attie Shanks, for the collection.
