This is a postcard featuring a panoramic view of the U.S. Army training base at Camp Funston, Kansas, during World War One.

Camp Funston was located between Manhattan and Junction City. It was named after Frederick Funston (1865-1917), who won the Congressional Medal of Honor and a promotion to Brigadier General when he captured Emilio Aguinaldo on Luzon in 1901. Camp Funston was the main training facility for soldiers from the midwest.
