This is the "Official Program" for the "Dunklin County High School Meet" held at Malden, Missouri, on 28-29 April 1922. Included were competitions in piano, violin, voice, spelling, public speaking, and track and field.

The Dunklin County High School Meet was a two-day event that included musical and declamatory as well as athletic competitions. Students participated from high schools in Kennett, Holcomb, Malden, Clarkton, Hornersville, Campbell, and Senath. Alfred C. Moon of Malden was President, Herbert Goza of Senath was Vice President, and Fannie Ellis Cocke of Holcomb was Secretary-Treasurer. Musical and declamatory events were held at the Liberty Theatre.
