This is certificate No. 520 for 32 shares of stock in the Osceola Lead and Zinc Mining Company at Webb City in Jasper County, Missouri. The certificate was issued on 5 April 1905 to Dr. W. H. Hawley, and was signed by President T. F. Coyne and Secretary S. R. Snook.

According to the certificate, the Osceola Lead and Zinc Mining Company was "Incorporated Under the Laws of Missouri" and capitalized at \$500,000. The shares were sold at \$5.00 each. T. F. Coyne, the President of the firm, was probably Thomas Francis Coyne, who was active in Joplin's Scottish Rite Masonic movement at the time (See WHMC-Rolla collection R748.).
