Mary Wherritt was born Mary Tunnell on July 11, 1911, in West Benton, Missouri. She was one of two daughters to Harold and Lula Tunnell. She married Jesse Minter Wherritt on January 29,

1949, in Jackson, Missouri. She and her sister Mildred, went on many trips through the United States and the world. She passed away on November 19, 2004, in Jefferson City, Missouri, at the age of 93.
