Christie Huck of the St. Louis Inter-Faith Committee on Latin America donated the groups records to the Western Historical Manuscript Collection on March 12, 2001.

St. Louis Inter-Faith Committee on Latin America is a non-profit group founded on October 1, 1982 to educate the St. Louis community about social and political problems in Latin America. It publishes a quarterly publication entitled *Inter-Faith Witness*. It also produces public events and projects to publicize such issues as immigrant rights; opposition to the US School of the Americas; economic injustice; debt cancellation for the third world; sweatshop labor; and US involvement in conflicts in Latin America. IFCLA also organizes delegations, sends material aid to various Latin American countries and advocates for human rights. It hosts interfaith liturgical services throughout the year to commemorate the struggles in Latin America and to recognize the religious basis for the social activism there.

The collection primarily includes a subject file of newsclippings on Latin America. It also includes some committee material, newsletters and correspondence. Arranged alphabetically.
