Paul Travers, a faculty member of the School of Education, University of Missouri-St. Louis from 1967 until his retirement in 2000, donated this collection in May 2013.

(Note: Dr. Ward Barnes was superintendent of the Normandy School District in the 1950s and 1960s. Dr. Barnes played a major role in the founding of the University of Missouri-St. Louis.)
