The Eliot Chapel Unitarian Church established itself as a place of worship in 1959 in Kirkwood, Missouri. It provides a place for men, women, children and families to worship together, socialize, and engage in social functions. Church members and leaders involve themselves in the social welfare of the Kirkwood community by supporting efforts to provide aid to the homeless and to feed the hungry. Discussions take place on interfaith matters, political dialogues and how to effect social change. The Eliot Chapel Unitarian Church is located at 100 S Taylor Avenue in Kirkwood, Missouri.

The Eliot Chapel Unitarian Church Newsletters collection covers the activities of its members from September 1967 to December 1972. It includes sermons from its leader, Webster Kitchell on the social and political issues of the era including race relations, politics and the conflict in Vietnam.
